3) PEC Chair Update

- a. Review of protocol for first PEC meeting of 2017-2018 to elect PEC positions
- b. Brenda expressed gratitude and highlighted her desire to be involved in setting up an alumni program
- c. School signage complete

4) Principal's Report

- a. Leading in the Spirit of the Catholic School
 - i. Faith formation: Mrs. Regush will be attending a weeklong Catholic leadership conference this summer.
 - ii. Staff faith facilitator attended eight day-long in-services.
 - iii. Five hours of professional development with Superintendent Office staff in Catholic worldview and intellectual tradition.
 - iv. Next Year: Liaising with St. Mark's College to provide instruction of the faith for staff. Teacher training and support for Aboriginal curriculum, Catholic worldview, and Catholic intellectual tradition.



b. Educational Leadership

- Completed data collection and analysis of early literacy growth for all students.
 Improvements for specific students and grouped students within grade levels in reading fluency.
- ii. Staff have participated together in 20 hours of redesigned curriculum development. Additional time of 5-25 hours dedicated to instructional unit plans and core competency assessments for students.
- iii. Nine teacher evaluations completed this year.
- iv. Staff Leadership Growth: three Master's degrees completed, one Master's degree in progress, and one Master's degree to begin shortly.

c. Management

- i. Accounting and Control Procedures: Audit recommendations from Walsh King resulted in the contracting of a chartered accountant to review practices at critical junctures such as tax credits, year-end audits, and budget proposal.
- ii. Water quality reviewed and monitored.

d. School Climate

- i. Placed 3rd of 38 schools at CISVA track meet; 2800 participants.
- ii. Fun Day this Friday; sports field opening to be determined.
- iii. Kindergarten Looking Ahead Day tomorrow. Heather will be PEC buddy family liaison.
- iv. Students displayed art for Fr. Francesco's reception which was well attended.
- v. Next Year: Focus on Personal and Social Responsibility Core Competency to develop interpersonal dynamics among students and manage personal challenges (anxiety).

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- c. Security/Front Door Locks/Tempered Glass
 - i. Subcommittee will be presented two proposals on security this week
 - ii. Cam discovered that new construction requires tempered glass on all exterior glass of institutions such as schools. Star of the Sea is still compliant due to grandfathering clause, but recommends revisiting this issue in the new school year as a future maintenance project.
